What can you do?

-  Save your cans! We need to recycle 5 million cans in a year to break even. This is less than 20% of the 27 million imported to STX each year.
-  Save ALL cans: **aluminum** (soda & beer) and **steel** (juice, soup, vegetables, etc). Please rinse all food from cans to minimize pests.
-  Designate a bin for recycling in your home, condo, church, school or business to collect cans. Bins can be new or existing trash cans.
-  Encourage others to participate in the recycling effort.
-  Please wait to drop off cans until the Recycle Center opens in Anna's Hope between Public Works and Gateway Gas. The opening has been delayed by Public Works constructing a drainage swale into the site. We are getting very close (May?)
-  Donate to or join RAVI - STX chapter. We need more funding and volunteers to complete projects. Go to www.usvircd.org/RAVI or call 636-938-6790. Meetings are the 2nd Tuesday of each month at the AARP office 5:30pm.
Buy a \$7 recycle sticker at the meeting - take it to Cost-U-Less service desk - receive a free bin with flip-up lid (a \$10 value - you save \$3).
